As a third generation partner, he oversees with his brother Mike all agricultural, strategic and operational aspects of the business. Steve is a board member and former chair of the Sonoma County Winegrape Commission where he has taken a lead role in its sustainability initiative. He is a former chair and board member of the Carneros Wine Alliance and also serves on the Development Committee of the Sonoma Valley Education Foundation.
